Ohio County Healthcare is pleased to announce that Dr. Susan Matthews, APRN has joined the OCH Team to provide behavioral healthcare services. Susan has been providing primary care to patients since 2002 and behavioral health since 2018.

Beginning August 30, 2021, Susan will continue providing behavioral health services only, at her current location of 1621 N. Main Street in Beaver Dam. As a certified Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR) therapist, her goal is to help people recover from trauma and other distressing life experiences, including PTSD, anxiety, depression, and panic disorders. Additionally, she will be working with Ohio County Healthcare to continue expanding mental health services to the region.

"I would like to thank you, my patient, for putting their trust in me to manage your healthcare needs and the healthcare needs of your family and friends. I do not take that trust lightly. It has been my pleasure to provide care for you throughout the years," states Dr. Matthews, APRN. "However, the need for mental health providers is great and the number of providers is few. I look forward to joining the OCH team and I am eager to expand the mental health services available to those in need."

Over the next several months, Susan and OCH will be transitioning the family medical needs of the Bluegrass Regional Healthcare patients to other Ohio County Healthcare providers. Available to accept patients is Amber Rollet, MD, who is OCH's newest board-certified family medicine physician. Dr. Rollet will be treating the full range of primary care patients from newborn to adults. She has an interest in all aspects of family care, with a special emphasis on women's health and geriatrics. "I look forward to establishing both my new home and practice in Ohio County," states Dr. Rollet. "It is exciting to be able to utilize my many years of training to help others."

To ensure there is no disruption in medical care, I will continue to provide medication refills until September 18, 2021. Please have your pharmacy send an electronic request to my office. I will be checking requests daily and filling meds for a 30-Day supply, if appropriate. Immediate medical care is available thru the Ohio County Quick Care. After you have transitioned to your new family medical provider, they can request a copy of your records.
