

COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE

Wednesday, January 13, 2021

Ohio County Healthcare, along with Emergency Management Services and Com-Care Ambulance, is currently scheduling for patients 70 and older to receive the Covid-19 Vaccine. Although it has been confusing, some health care organizations in other counties have begun vaccinating their 1b population due to the number of vaccines left over from finishing their 1a population vaccinations. The amount of vaccine overage has varied from location to location depending on the amount of vaccine initially received and the amount of 1a population in that area that has declined vaccination. Because every location received enough vaccine to cover their designated 1a population, but not everyone opted to receive the vaccination, this allowed areas to vaccinate 1b populations earlier than scheduled. The larger the population in that area, the more vaccines have been left over to use for this purpose. It has allowed other areas to provide mass vaccination options while the smaller populations have had very little vaccine left to distribute for early 1b vaccination.
